The City Council of the City of Newport Beach,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the City Council of the City of Newport Beach, in the County of Orange, State of California, is hereby authorized to construct Orange Street at grade across

- (6) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted bu subsequent order.
- (7) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders, relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossings, as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, public convenience and necessity demand such action.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
