**ORIGINAL**ORDER

The Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, on December 1, 1931, applied for authority to abandon its agency at Ivanpah Station on its main line, in San Bernardino County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that thirty-five passenger tickets were sold at said agency during the year ending September 30, 1931; that 185 less than carload shipments were received and forwarded at said station during the same period; that the nearest agency to the west is at Cima, a distance of 13.3 miles, and to the east at Nipton, a distance of 10 miles; that interested shippers and receivers of freight have been interviewed by applicant, and have expressed their approval of the proposed agency abandonment, provided said station is retained as a non-agency station; that the abandonment of said agency will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; that the station will be continued as a non-agency station; and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the agency is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation, on December 17, 1931, signified, in writing, that it does not object to the granting of this application.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company is hereby authorized to abandon its agency at its station of Ivanpah, located on its main line in San Bernardino County, and to change its station records and tariffs accordingly; provided that said station be continued as a non-agency station, subject to the following conditions:

1. Applicant shall store less than carload shipments of freight in the station building, under lock and key, and shall appoint a custodian of the key to said station, for the purpose of caring for the less than carload freight shipments.

2. Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein, and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

3. The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void, if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
