BY THE COMMISSION:

FOURTE SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon consideration of the record in the above entitled proceeding, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the fifth paragraph of the order in Decision No. 24423 of January 25, 1932, and as amended, be and it is hereby further amended and modified to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Motor Transport Company operations by truck between El Centro and Holtville shall within sixty (60) days, and between Santa Barbara and Montecito, and Los Angeles and Vernon within one hundred twenty (120) days from the effective date of this order be discontinued until and when the said Company has first obtained from this Commission a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing such operations, or until the person or corporation with whom Pacific Motor Transport Company has contracted for such service has obtained such certificate."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects our opinion and order entered January 25, 1932, and as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
