ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, on April 6, 1932, applied for authority to abandon its agency at Kincaid Station on the Second District of its Los Angeles Division in Los Angeles County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that no passenger, express or telegraph business was transacted at said agency station during the year ending December 31, 1932; that the only freight business transacted at said station is the shipment of rock and gravel, which is entirely the business of Consolidated Rock Products Company; that the Consolidated Rock Products Company has advised that it has no objection to the granting of this application; that the abandonment of said agency will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; that the station will be continued as a non-agency station; and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the agency is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon its agency at its station of Kincaid, located on the Second District of its Los Angeles Division, in Los Angeles County, and to change its station records and tariffs accordingly; provided that said station be continued as a non-agency station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein, and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void, if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
