Sacramento Northern Railway, a corporation, on April 14, 1932, applied for authority to abandon a non-agency station and remove a spur track located at Dyke in the County of Yolo, State of California.

Applicant alleges that but one carload shipment was made from said station during the calendar year 1931; that the nearest station to the west is Lisbon, .9 of a mile distant, and to the east Riverview, 2.1 miles distant, and that there is no justification for the continued maintenance of said track and non-agency station. It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sacramento Northern Railway is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Dyke in Yolo County, State of California; to remove a spur track located at said station; to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records and to cancel, in conformity with the rules

of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
