FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company having notified the Commission that the mile post and the angle of crossing of the crossing at grade with its tracks heretofore authorized in the above entitled proceeding will not be in accordance with the information previously furnished and incorporated in Decision No. 24632 in said application, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 24632, dated March 28, 1932, in the above entitled application, be modified as follows:

Condition (1) shall read as follows:

The above crossing shall be identified as
 Crossing No. AU-110.6.

Condition (3) shall be modified to provide that the crossing be constructed at an angle of approximately 82 degrees to the railroad.

In all other respects Decision No. 24632 shall remain

in full force and effect.
