**ORIGINAL**O P I N I O N

The Commission by order dated April 27, 1932 in the above entitled proceeding suspended until May 25, 1932, Pacific Motor Transport Company Local Express Tariff C.R.C. No. 11 and original pages 17-A and 20-A of The Western Pacific Railroad Company Freight Tariff G.F.D. No. 663, C.R.C. No. 335, filed to become effective May 16, 1932. The tariffs were suspended for the reason that the rates contained therein did not appear to be in the public interest.

The matter was set for hearing before Commissioner Carr at San Francisco May 6, 1932. Before the proceeding was heard, however, respondents applied to the Commission for authority to withdraw the tariffs. This authority was granted and the schedules cancelled on May 16, 1932. The cause for suspension has now been removed and our order of April 27, 1932 should therefore be vacated and this suspension proceeding discontinued.

O R D E R

Upon consideration of all the facts of record, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that our order of April 27, 1932 in the above entitled proceeding suspending Pacific Motor Transport Company Local Express Tariff C.R.C. No. 11 and original pages 17-A and 20-A of The Western Pacific Railroad Company Freight Tariff G.F.D. No. 663, C.R.C. No. 335, be and it is hereby vacated and set aside.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this proceeding be and it is hereby discontinued.
