In the Matter of the Application of J.A. GRAVES and ALICE H. GRAVES, doing business under the name and style of J.A. GRAVES WATER COMPANY, for an order permitting them to cease doing business as a Public Utility.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

J.A. Graves and Alice H. Graves, doing business under the name and style of J.A. Graves Water Company, having made application to the Railroad Commission for authority to discontinue their public utility water service in and in the vicinity of the City of Alhambra, County of Los Angeles, State of California, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the authority should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that J.A. Graves and Alice H. Graves, doing business under the fictitious firm name and style of J.A. Graves Water Company, be and they are hereby authorized to discontinue, on and after the first day of July, 1932, all their public utility water business in and in the vicinity of the City of Alhambra, County of Los Angeles, State of California, and thereupon stand relieved of all further public utility obligations and liabilities in connection therewith, subject to the following condition:

Within ten (10) days from the date of this Order, said J.A. Graves and Alice H. Graves

shall duly notify in writing all their consumers, if any, now receiving water service from the J.A. Graves Water Company, of their intention to discontinue water service on and after the first day of July, 1932, and said J.A. Graves and Alice H. Graves shall file with this Commission, within ten (10) days from the date of this Order, a certified statement that such notice has been duly given. In the event there are no consumers now being served by J.A. Graves and Alice H. Graves, said J.A. Graves and Alice H. Graves shall file with this Commission, within twenty (20) days from the date of this Order, a certified statement indicating that such is a fact.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
