E. W. Thompson having made application for a license to engage in the business of "motor carrier transportation agent", and this being a matter in which a public hearing

is not deemed necessary and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Secretary of the Commission issue to E. W. Thompson a license to engage in the business of "motor carrier transportation agent" as such is defined by Statutes of 1931, Chapter 638, page 1362, at No.833 South Grand Avenue and a branch office at 116 East Fifth Street, both in the City of Los Angeles for the sale of tickets for Coast to Coast Stages, Union Pacific Stages of California, Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc. and Pickwick-Greyhound Lines, as set forth in the application, provided that E. W. Thompson shall first file a bond in the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), the form and substance of which bond shall be as set forth in Decision No.24504, on Application No.17796.
