O R D E R

Application having been made by M.C. Randolph, Mary H. Randolph, Thomas D. Davis, Marguerite Davis and Daniel Bona, as Trustees for the former Plymouth Water Company whose corporate existence expired on the 17th day of November, 1931, for permission to transfer all of the properties formerly owned by said Plymouth Water Company on November 17, 1931, to M.C. Randolph, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request should be granted,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the said M.C. Randolph, Mary H. Randolph, Thomas D. Davis, Marguerite Davis and Daniel Bona, as Trustees for the former Plymouth Water Company, be and they are hereby authorized to sell and transfer to M.C. Randolph all of the properties, rights and interest owned on the 17th day of November, 1931, by the said Plymouth Water Company as said properties, rights and interest are more particularly described in the application herein and in "Exhibit A" attached

thereto, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the 31st day of August, 1932, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said M.C. Randolph on or before said 31st day of August, 1932.
2. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
