IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to publish, on two days' notice to the Commission and the public, a reduced rate for said tour of \$5.00 in place of the rate of \$6.00 heretofore authorized by Decision No.23302, dated January 19, 1931, on Application No.17042.
