## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In its Decision No. 24239, dated November 25, 1931, in the above application, this Commission ordered as follows:

"IT IS EEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the rights and privileges herein granted will become null and void on June 30, 1932, unless West Coast Gas & Fuel Company shall, prior to said June 30, 1932, have completed and placed in operation the eforesaid plants."

Under date of June 14, 1932, West Coast Gas & Fuel Company addressed the following letter to the Commission:

Dear Sir: Re: Decision No. 24239-West Coast Gas & Fuel Co.

The undersigned Corporation respectfully requests an extension of time for the fulfillment of the above said permit granted under Decision No. 24239.

"This request for an extension is due to the present condition of the financial market and for the purpose of making available the funds required for the carrying out of the proposed projects in accordance with said permit.

It is anticipated that by January 1, 1933, the authorization granted to this applicant will be carried out. We, therefore, make a request for an extension to and including said date of January 1, 1933.

The Commission being of the opinion that this request should be granted, that a public hearing in this matter is not necessary, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above quoted portion of the Order in Decision No. 24239 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the rights and privileges herein granted will become null and void on January 2, 1933, unless West Coast Gas & Fuel Company shall, prior to said January 2, 1933, have completed and placed in operation the aforesaid plants.

In all other respects Decision No. 24239 shall remain in full force and effect.
