O P I N I O N

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, applies under Section 63 of the Public Utilities Act for an order granting permission to establish in connection with its pick-up and delivery service a minimum charge rule between Los Angeles and various points in Southern California in conjunction with the rates and charges set forth in its Tariff No. 14815-A, C.R.C. 665.

The rule to be established is as follows:

On shipments weighing 25 lbs. or less, \$0.35 per shipment.
 On shipments weighing over 25 lbs., .50 per shipment.

The minimum charge now in effect is, for 100 lbs. or less, 35 cents; over 100 lbs., 50 cents. The proposed change will create slight increases.

Under date of June 13, 1932, Application 18127, Decision 24863, 27 auto freight lines, the applicants, and the Pacific Motor Transport Company, intervener, were authorized to publish the minimum charge here proposed. The record in Application 18127 shows

that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company through an oversight was not represented as an intervener at the proceeding. Relief sought in the instant proceeding is exactly the same as was granted to the Santa Fe competitors.

We are accordingly of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company be and it is hereby authorized to establish within forty (40) days from the date of this order the minimum charge rates as set forth in the application, viz.:

On shipments weighing 25 lbs. or less, \$0.35 per shipment.
On shipments weighing over 25 lbs., .50 per shipment.
