## ORDER DENYING REHEARING

Oral argument herein was heard by me on March 10, 1932 upon the petition of La Canada Chamber of Commerce et al for rehearing asking that Decision No. 24256 herein be modified by striking out that portion authorizing applicant to discontinue service on that route described on page 18 of said decision, as follows:

"2. Montrose via Verdugo Road to La Canada; thence via Foothill Boulevard and Michigan Avenue to La Crescenta."

Arguments were made upon the evidence adduced in the main hearing and after careful consideration of all that was presented I find that the order as previously made by the Commission is supported and justified by said evidence and that the request for modification should be denied. I recommend the following form of order:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition for rehearing aforesaid asking modification of the order herein made by Decision No. 24256, dated November 23, 1931, be and the same hereby is denied.
