ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On May 13, 1932, an order to show cause was issued, directing J. O. Bray to appear before Commissioner Carr at Fresno on June 14, 1932, to show cause why he should not be punished for contempt, and directing that a true copy of the Application for Order to Show Cause and Affidavit of Service (filed with the Commission on April 29, 1932) and of the order to show cause be served upon J. O. Bray at least ten days prior to the hearing. On May 13, 1932 copies thereof were forwarded to the Sheriff of the County of Fresno for service, and it having been impossible to effect service within said time, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order to show cause issued on May 13, 1932 is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
