BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (1) of Decision No. 24677, dated April 11, 1932, be modified to read as follows:

"(1) The new crossing shall be identified as Crossing No. 31-54.5."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Condition (4) of said decision be modified to read as follows:

"(4) Upon completion of the crossing herein authorized and upon its being opened to public use and travel, the existing crossing marked 'railroad crossing to be abandoned' on the map accompanying the application and located approximately 300 feet north of the crossing herein authorized, shall be legally abandoned and effectively closed to public use and travel."

In all other respects the Commission's Decision No. 24677 shall remain in full force and effect.
