FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon further consideration of the record in the above entitled proceeding and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the third paragraph of our order entered June 13, 1932 in the above entitled proceedings be and it is hereby amended and modified to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that defendants, Southern Pacific Company, Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, Pacific Electric Railway Company and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, according as they participate in the transportation, be and they are hereby ordered to establish on or before sixty (60) days from the effective date of this order, on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public, rates which shall not exceed those found reasonable in the opinion which precedes this order."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects our order entered June 13, 1932, Decision No. 24871 shall remain in full force and effect.
