ORDER

The Sacramento Northern Railway Company, a corporation, on June 17, 1932, applied for authority to abandon its agency at Rio Linda station in Sacramento County, State of California.

Accompanying the application is a comparative statement showing the amount of business transacted at Rio Linca station during the calendar years 1930 and 1931, and also for the five months' period, January 1 to May 31, 1932, as follows:

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The California Farm Bureau Federation has signified that it does not object to the granting of this application.

A member of the Transportation Division of the Commission's Engineering Department has made an investigation of the matter and his report shows that the interested shippers and receivers of freight at Rio Linda have indicated that they will not oppose the granting of this application.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Socramento Morthern Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon its agency at the station of Rio Linda, located on the main line of the Sacramento Northern Railway Company on its Second Subdivision in Sacramento County, California, and to change its records and tariffs accordingly, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall give the public at least ten (10) days' notice prior to the abandonment of said agency by posting notice in a conspicuous place at said station.
- (2) Said agency is to be continued as a non-agency station.
- (3) Less-than-carload shipments shell be stored under lock and key in the company's warehouse, the key thereto to be obtained from custodian located near said station, notice of which shall be maintained at the warehouse advising patrons where the key may be secured.
- (4) Applicant shall within thirty (30) days thereafter notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment herein authorized and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (5) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
