It appears that a public hearing is not necessary heroin and that said request should be granted. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (2) of Decision No. 24695, dated April 18, 1932, be and it is amended to read as follows: The entire expense of constructing said grade (2)separation shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement or agreements to be entered into between applicant and Pacific Electric Rail-way Company. Applicant shall file a certified copy or copies of said agreement or agreements with this Commission within one hundred and twenty (120) days after the date hereof. Should said -1agreement or agreements not be filed within the above time and further time not be granted by subsequent order, said costs will be apportioned by further Supplemental Order.

In all other respects Decision No. 24695 shall remain in full force and effect.
