IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Secretary of the Commission issue to Henry E. Graham a license to engage in the business of "motor carrier transportation agent" as such is defined by Statutes of 1931, Chapter 638, page 1362, at 208 South Hill Street, Los Angeles, California, provided, that Henry E. Graham shall first file a bond in the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.), the form and substance of which bond shall be as set forth in Decision No. 24504, on Application No. 17796. Under the license hereby ordered to be issued transportation may be sold over the Los Angeles Chicago Stages only.
