**ORIGINAL**OPINION and ORDER

By this application Roy Davis requests authority to suspend service as a common carrier of passengers and express between Red Bluff and Gerber until December 1, 1932. Applicant alleges that the revenues now being received are insufficient to meet the cost of operation. We believe this is not a matter requiring a public hearing and that the application should be granted. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be and it is hereby granted Roy Davis to suspend until December 1, 1932, all operations for the transportation of passengers and express between Red Bluff and Gerber, provided applicant shall file supplements to his tariffs and time schedules showing the suspension of service as herein authorized.
