OPINION AND ORDER VACATING  
ORDER OF SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION

The Commission by order dated June 30, 1932, in the above entitled proceeding suspended until August 31, 1932, Item 155-E of Supplements Nos. 26 and 27 to Local Freight Tariff C.R.C. No. 6 of Motor Service Express, Inc., containing, in addition to other rates, a reduced rate of 30 cents per 100 pounds applying on groceries, as described in Item 300 of the tariff, from San Bernardino to Indio, Mecca, Thermal or Coachella.

The matter was set for hearing before Commissioner Stevenot at Los Angeles August 2, 1932. Before the proceeding was heard respondent applied to the Commission and obtained authority to cancel the suspended rates. The cancellation there-  
 or became effective July 18, 1932, in Supplement No. 30 to Tar-  
 iff C.R.C. No. 6. The cause for suspension has thus been re-  
 moved. Our order of suspension will be vacated.

O R D E R

Upon consideration of all the facts on record, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that our order of June 30, 1932 in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby vacated and set aside as of August 2, 1932 and this proceeding be discontinued.
