ORDER

WHEREAS, Knights Landing Telephone Exchange, O. Reinhardt owner, having filed an application with this Commission requesting authority to file and place in effect a rate of five cents (5¢) for each local telephone message from a public pay station; and

WHEREAS, the furnishing of public pay station service will be in the interest of the subscribers of the service of Knights Landing Telephone Exchange and of the public; and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Knights Landing Telephone Exchange be and it is hereby authorized to charge and collect the sum of five cents (5¢) for each local telephone message from a public pay station on and after September 1st, 1932.

The authority herein granted is subject to the condition that said rate be submitted for filing with this Commission

on and before August 26th, 1932.
