OPINION AND ORDER

M. L. Isham, an individual, operating under the name Rio Vista Transit Company, an automotive service for the transportation of passengers and property between Isleton, Rio Vista, Rio Vista Junction and intermediate points, has made application to abandon such service and requesting the Commission to cancel his operative rights. These rights were created by Decision No. 11332, dated December 7, 1922, on Application No. 8477 and have been exercised by applicant since then.

Applicant alleges that between February and August 1, 1932, only 952 passengers were transported. During June 93 passengers were carried and during July 43. The expense of operation for the period is reported by applicant at \$1355.09 and revenues at \$710.23.

This is a matter in which a public hearing appears unnecessary; also it appears the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that M. L. Isham, operating under the name of Rio Vista Transit Company, between Isleton, Rio Vista, Rio Vista Junction and intermediate points, be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue such operation, provided, applicant shall immediately

file with this Commission cancellation of his tariffs and time schedules now on file for such operation, at least five (5) days before such discontinuance; and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that applicant's rights heretofore granted by Decision No. 11332 on Application No. 8477 be and the same hereby are revoked and annulled.
