OPINION AND ORDER

M. Bernardo, operating under the name Chico - Rod Bluff Freight Line, has requested authority to suspend all schedules and operation until April 1, 1933. The operating right for such service, between Chico and Red Bluff and intermediates, was authorized by Decision No. 15494 dated October 7, 1925, on Application No. 10860.

Applicant alleges that the operations cannot be conducted without great loss, which he is unable to bear, due to the competition of uncertificated carriers.

This is a matter that does not require a public hearing.

The application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that M. Bornardo be and he hereby is authorized to suspend all service between Chico and Red Bluff and intermediate points, as authorized by Decision No. 15494 on Application No. 10860, until April 1, 1933, provided, applicant shall file immediately with this Commission withdrawal and sus-

pension of his time schedules at least five (5) days before dis-
continuance of such service.
