OPINION AND ORDER

In this proceeding the Railroad Commission is asked to make an order authorizing the transfer of the warehouse business and equipment located at Riz, heretofore operated by Beggs and Juney a copartnership to Frank L. Juney an individual. It appears from the petition that the partnership of Beggs and Juney was dissolved September 1, 1931 and the business taken over by Frank L. Juney, an individual. Through an oversight authority to transfer the properties was not obtained from the Commission.

The transfer is by consent of both parties and no monetary consideration is involved. Frank L. Juney will continue to operate the warehouse as a public utility under rates, rules and regulations shown in Warehouse Tariff No. 1, C.R.C. No. 1 effective September 1, 1929 filed in name of Beggs and Juney. The proposed transfer will not result in any curtailment of service.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter not requiring a formal hearing and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same is hereby granted subject to the following conditions:

1. Beggs and Juney a copartnership and Frank L. Juney shall join in common supplement to the tariff now on file with the Railroad Commission in name of Beggs and Juney, applicants Beggs and Juney on the one hand withdrawing and applicant Frank L. Juney on the other hand accepting and adopting such tariff and all effective supplements thereto.
2. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be sold, leased, transferred or assigned, nor service thereunder discontinued, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to the sale, lease, transfer or discontinuance has first been secured.
3. The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
