<u>OFINION</u> Roy Davis, operating a transportation service under the name of Red Bluff-Gerber Stage for the transportation of passengers and property between Red Bluff and Gerber, has made application to discontinue all service and requesting the revocation of authority therefor as created by Decision No. 23019, dated October 28, 1930, on Application No. 16958. By Decision No. 25011, dated August 1, 1932, applicant was authorized to suspend service until December 1,

1932, due to the fact that business had been conducted for some months at a loss. He now alleges that there is not sufficient business to justify continuance of the operation.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

## <u>ORDER</u>

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Roy Davis, operating automotive service for the transportation of passengers and property between Red Bluff and Gerber be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue all service between termini and for intermediate points, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 23019 on Application No. 16958 and Decision No. 25011 on Application No. 18238 be and the same hereby are revoked and annulled, provided, however, that applicant shall within fifteen (15) days from date hereof file with the Commission cancellation of his tariffs and time schedules covering the service heretofore authorized.
