OPINION AND ORDER

This application, filed on September 12, 1932, requests a certificate to operate a common carrier trucking service for the transportation of packages with a maximum weight of fifty pounds over nine specified routes out of Los Angeles. It was set for hearing at the same time and place as Case No. 3299 (filed July 25, 1932) United Parcel Service of Los Angeles, Inc. v. 20th Century Delivery Service, Inc. Upon submission of the complaint the application was removed from the calendar. Under the facts disclosed in the record in the complaint proceeding, and in view of the opinion, findings and order therein, issued today and directing this applicant to cease and desist unauthorized common carrier operations between points involved in the present application, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Application No. 18406 is hereby dismissed.
