## ORDER ALTERING ROUTE

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Richard C. Winchell, applicant herein, be and he is hereby authorized to establish, in lieu of the route fixed by Decision No.24419, dated January 25, 1932, the following route, and to operate thereover:

"Leave terminal Main and D Streets, Tustin, north on D to First, west on First to Wright, north on Wright to 4th Street, west on 4th Street to Birch Street, south on Birch to Third, east on Third (Broadway terminal), north on Broadway to 4th Street, east on 4th Street to Spurgeon, south on Spurgeon to 3rd Street, west on 3rd Street to Bush Street, north on Bush to 4th Street and east on 4th Street over same route to Tustin, California."

In all other respects Decision No.24419 shall remain unchanged.
