SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 25029 dated August 1, 1932 the Railroad Commission authorized Sacramento Northern Railway to sell to Columbia Steel Corporation certain property described in its application. Applicant now reports that the name of the purchaser, referred to in its original application as Columbia Steel Corporation, had been changed to Columbia Steel Company and that through inadvertence Parcel No. 2 of the property described in said application was incorrectly described, and an additional parcel, intended to be included in the sale, omitted.

Sacramento Northern Railway having asked the Commission to amend Decision No. 25029 so as to permit the sale to Columbia Steel Company of the property described in its supplemental application, the Commission having considered applicant's request and being of the opinion that such request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that this Commission's Decision No. 25029, dated August 1, 1932, be, and it is hereby, amended so as to permit Sacramento Northern Railway to sell to Columbia Steel Company those certain parcels of property described in its supplemental application filed in this proceeding October 17, subject to the following conditions:-

1. Applicant shall within thirty(30) days after the transfer of the aforesaid properties, file with the Commission a copy of the deed under which said properties were transferred, and a statement showing the consideration received for the properties.

2. The authority herein granted shall not be construed as a determination of the value of the property for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

3. The authority herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

4. The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
