OPINION AND ORDER

D. M. Rife, operating under authority of this Commission granted by Decision No. 16777 on Application No. 12837 and Decision No. 17442 on Application No. 13129, an automobile service for the transportation of persons and/or property between Fresno and Riverdale and intermediate points, has made application to the Commission for authority to discontinue said service and for the revocation of said operating rights.

Applicant alleges that his receipts for the last four months, totaling \$198.85, have caused an out-of-pocket loss of \$14.04, his expenses for the same period, without including depreciation or labor in the operation of the stage, having been \$295.30.

This is a matter in which we believe a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that D. M. Rife, operating an automobile service for the transportation of passengers and/or property between Fresno and Riverdale, be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue said service, provided applicant shall

file with this Commission withdrawal and cancellation of his time tables and tariffs therefor now on file with this Commission; and provided further, that applicant shall discontinue such service only after posting notices at his terminals and in his vehicles of the discontinuance of service under the order of this Commission at least five (5) days before such discontinuance actually occurs.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 16777 on Application No. 12837, and Decision No. 17442 on Application No. 13129, be and the same are hereby revoked and nullified.

For all other purposes the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
