OPINION and ORDER

RECEIVED

Charles Bouchard, operating automotive service as a common carrier of passengers and property between Litchfield and Standish requests authority to discontinue such operations and also asks revocation of the certificate therefor.

Applicant alleges that his sole remaining shipper has ceased the use of his service and that there is no other business available.

The service sought to be discontinued was authorized by Decision No. 11703, dated February 21, 1923, on Application No. 8673.

This is a matter in which a public hearing does not appear to be necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application herein be granted, provided applicant shall post notice of discontinuance of service at each of his terminals five (5) days before such service is discontinued and shall within ten (10) days after such discontinuance file cancellation of his time schedules and tariffs therefor.

For all other purposes the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from date hereof.
