BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Home Telephone Company, furnishing telephone service to its stockholders in territory south of the Town of Colusa, Colusa County, herein makes application to the Railroad Commission to discontinue service over its line. The applicant states that thirteen stockholders were connected to its line; that the line was in poor state of repair; that funds are not available to make the necessary repairs; that a majority of applicant's stockholders have requested applicant to discontinue its service and have elected to dissolve said corporation; and, that Colusa County Telephone Company is furnishing service in the same territory and offers to serve all of applicant's stockholders.

It appears that a public hearing in this matter is not required and that applicant's request should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Home Telephone Company be and it is hereby granted authority to discontinue public utility .

telephone service operations in the territory south of the town
of Colusa, Colusa County, on and after December 1, 1932.
