IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (2) of the Commission's Order in its Decision No. 25256, dated October 10, 1932, in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (2) The entire expense of constructing and maintaining said crossing shall be in accordance with the agreement entered into on May 25, 1932, between the City of Long Beach and the Pacific Electric Railway Company.

In all other respects the order in said decision shall remain in full force and effect.
