OPINION and ORDER

ORIGINAL

Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc. requests amendment of paragraph 3 of the order in Decision No. 23244, dated December 31, 1930 on Application No. 16929, permitting applicant to establish alternate routes for service between San Francisco and Valona Junction via Oakland or Berkeley. Applicant seeks authority to divert through traffic through West Berkeley across San Francisco Bay via the Southern Pacific Golden Gate Ferries from and to San Francisco (Hyde Street Pier); and also to reroute service between Seventh Street and San Pablo Avenue via Peralta Street. The proposed routes are to avoid traffic and will be used only as alternative routes on schedules not serving applicant's Oakland terminal. This is a matter in which we believe a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc. applicant herein, be and it is hereby authorized to route its service between San Francisco, Oakland and Berkeley and points beyond as follows:

Between San Francisco and Berkeley via Southern Pacific Golden Gate Ferries, Ltd. between Hyde Street (San Francisco) and Berkeley Pier, thence to West Berkeley and from Oakland Pier via Seventh Street and Peralta Street to Junction with present route at Peralta Street and San Pablo Avenue, Emeryville; said routes to be utilized by applicant's schedules which are not required to operate via Oakland Terminal,

and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the rights herein granted for said alternative routes be and the same are hereby consolidated with applicant's rights as granted by Decision No. 23244 and supplements thereto particularly as amending paragraph 3 in the order thereof; and applicant is hereby authorized to file such tariffs and time schedules as shall make the operations effective in conformity with the General Orders of this Commission.
