O R D E R

**ORIGINAL**

The County of Yolo and Sacramento Northern Railway, on October 24, 1932, applied jointly for authority to construct a public road and a spur track crossing at grade in the vicinity of Lovdal Station. It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein; that it is neither reasonable nor practicable at this time to provide a grade separation or to avoid a grade crossing at the point mentioned and that the application should be granted, subject to certain conditions,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo and Sacramento Northern Railway are hereby authorized to construct a county road and a spur track crossing at grade at the location more particularly described in the application and as shown by the map attached thereto, subject to the following conditions and not otherwise:

- (1) The above crossing shall be identified as Crossing No. 8B-3.2-C.
- (2) The expense of constructing and maintaining the crossing shall be apportioned as proposed in the application.

- (3) The crossing shall be constructed of a width of not less than thirty (30) feet and with grades of approach not greater than one (1) per cent; shall be constructed equal or superior to type shown as Standard No. 3 in our General Order No. 72; shall be protected by two (2) Standard No. 1 crossing signs as specified in our General Order No. 75, and shall in every way be made suitable for the passage thereon of vehicles and other road traffic.
- (4) Applicants shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the installation of said crossing and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (5) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.
- (6) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, public convenience and necessity demand such action.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
