O P I N I O N

The Commission by order dated October 28, 1932, in the
above entitled proceeding suspended until November 28, 1932, Item
2016 $\frac{1}{2}$ of Supplement No. 8 to C.R.C. 11, Proportional Freight Tar-
iff of Richards Trucking and Warehouse Company, naming reduced
rates for the transportation of glycerine, refined, in iron drums
or in metal cans in cases or cartons, minimum weight 30,000 pounds,
from Los Angeles Harbor District to Los Angeles. The rate includes
a maximum of five deliveries at Los Angeles.

A public hearing was held before Examiner Geary at Los
Angeles November 16, 1932. At the hearing respondent stated that

it desired to withdraw the suspended rates. The authority therefore was granted and the rates cancelled effective November 26, 1932. Thus the cause for suspension has been removed. Our order of October 28, 1932, should accordingly be vacated and this suspension proceeding discontinued.

O R D E R

Upon consideration of all the facts of record, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that our order of October 28, 1932, in the above entitled proceeding, suspending Item 2016 $\frac{1}{2}$ of Supplement 8 to C.R.C. 11, Proportional Freight Tariff of Richards Trucking and Warehouse Company, be and it is hereby vacated and set aside.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this proceeding be and it is hereby discontinued.
