James Rusconi, operating a service for the transportation of passengers and property between San Geronimo and Nicasio and intermediate points, as authorized by Decision No.16007, dated February 15, 1926, on application No.12507, requests authority to discontinue the service between termini and intermediate points for the transportation of passengers only. He alleges that he has carried no passengers for a long period. Applicant requests an order revoking said operating right.

This is a matter in which a public hearing appears to be unnecessary.

The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that James Rusconi be and he hereby is authorized to abandon and discontinue all service for passengers only between San Geronimo and Nicasio and intermediate points.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No.16007, on application No.12507, therefore be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
