O R D E R

Railway Express Agency, Inc., on November 23, 1932 applied for authority to abandon its agency at Windsor Station on the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company's main line in Sonoma County, California.

Applicant alleges that \$549.33 express business was transacted at said agency station during the twelve-month period ending October 31, 1932. On November 18, 1932 the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company changed to a seasonal agency station at this point, as authorized by the Commission's Decision No. 25307 in Application No. 18354, dated October 31, 1932. In the past the agent of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company has acted as express agent at this point on a commission basis and in view of the small amount of remuneration applicant has been unable to secure anyone to act as its agent during the period that the railroad agency is closed. The abandonment of said agency will not involve the entire abandonment of service, as the express shipments moving in and out of this point would be handled by express messenger on train stopping at said point, and, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the agency is
