BY THE COMMISSION: SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER In its Decision No. 24239, dated November 23, 1931, in the above application, this Commission ordered as follows: "IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the rights and privileges herein granted will become null and void on June 30, 1932, unless West Coast Gas & Fuel Company shall, prior to said June 30, 1932, have completed and placed in operation the aforesaid plants."

in operation the aforesaid plants."

Thereafter, on written request of applicant, this Commission in its Decision No. 24913, dated June 27, 1932, amended the above quoted portion of the Order in Decision No. 24239 to

read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the rights and privileges herein granted will become null and void on January 2, 1933, unless West Coast Gas & Fuel Company shall, prior to said January 2, 1933, have completed and placed in operation the aforesaid plants."

Subsequently, in a letter dated December 2, 1932, West Coast Gas & Fuel Company requested that the time for fulfilling the conditions of the permit granted under Decision No. 24239 be further extended to June 1, 1935.

The Commission being of the opinion that this request should be granted, that a public hearing in this matter is not necessary, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above quoted portion of the Order in Decision No. 24239 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the rights and privileges herein granted will become null and void on June 1, 1933, unless West Coast Gas & Fuel Company shall, prior to said June 1, 1933, have completed and placed in operation the aforesaid plants.

In all other respects Decision No. 24239 shall remain in full force and effect.
