FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon further consideration of the record in the above
entitled proceeding, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that condition 2 in the above en-
titled order be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Applicant shall file, in triplicate, and make
effective within a period of not to exceed thirty
(30) days from the date hereof, on not less than
one day's notice to the Railroad Commission and the
public, a tariff or tariffs constructed in accord-
ance with the requirements of this Commission's
General Order which, in volume and effect, shall
be identical with the rates and rules shown in the
exhibits attached to the application in so far as
they conform to the certificate herein granted."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that condition 3 in the
above entitled order be and it is hereby cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Decision No. 25457 of December 19, 1932, shall remain in full force and effect.
