O P I N I O N

E.N. Cuneo, operating automotive service as a common carrier for the transportation of passengers and freight between Jackson and Ranger Station and intermediate points, as authorized by Decision No. 15933, dated February 6, 1926, on Application No. 12473 and Decision No. 18100, dated March 21, 1927, on Application No. 12886, has made application to suspend all service until April 1, 1933.

Applicant alleges that the construction activities of Pacific Gas and Electric Company in the Ranger Station region, which furnished the bulk of the traffic have been suspended until spring and that little other traffic is available and not enough to support difficult winter operation.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that E.N. Cuneo be and he is hereby authorized to suspend all operations between Jackson and Ranger Station and intermediate points until April 1, 1933, provided applicant shall immediately file, in duplicate, suspension of time schedules and cancellation of tariffs, in triplicate, within fifteen days from date hereof.
