O P I N I O N

D.O. Sullivan operating, under the name Sullivan Auto Stage Line, a service for the transportation of passengers and property between Stonyford and Willows and intermediate points as authorized by Decision No. 13392 on Application No. 9955, has made application to abandon and discontinue passenger service only and for the revocation of authority for this service, due to the fact that he has sustained losses by reason of the meager patronage afforded. Applicant also maintains a service for the transportation of property between the same termini and intermediate points but does not desire that this portion of the service be abandoned.

This is a matter in which we believe a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that D.O. Sullivan be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue the transportation of passengers between Stonyford and Willows and intermediate points as authorized by Decision No. 13392 on Application No. 9955, provided, however, that before such discontinuance he shall post notice, five days before the effective date of such discontinuance, at the terminals and in the vehicles used for passenger service.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that that portion of Decision No. 13392 on Application No. 9955 authorizing the transportation of persons be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled only insofar as it applies to the transportation of passengers,

provided applicant shall within fifteen (15) days after termination of such service, file with this Commission cancellation of his passenger tariffs and time schedules.
