SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rule 10 of General Order
No. 86, promulgated by this Commission by its Decision No. 22349,
in the above numbered proceeding, and effective May 11, 1930, be
and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

Rule 10. TRANSPORTATION OF ANIMALS.

Dogs or other animals transported in
vehicles used for the transportation of
passengers must be crated or muzzled, except,
however, that trained dogs, when guiding a blind
person, may be carried without being crated or
muzzled.

For all other purposes, prior decisions in this proceed-
ing shall remain in full force and effect.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on
the date hereof.
