## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Bakersfield and Kern Electric Railway Company, on January 9, 1933, filed a request with the Commission asking that Decision No. 25037, dated August 5, 1932, in the above entitled matter be amended so that applicant may continue in effect its basic five (5) cent fare on its lines to February 8, 1933, and at that time place in effect a basic ten (10) cent fare as shown on Exhibit "C," attached to the application.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that said request should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Order in Decision No. 25037 be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Bakersfield and Kern Electric Railway. Company, is authorized (1) to file and make effective on its system for the period in said schedule specified, the fares, rules and regulations set forth in Exhibit 'A' to the application herein, the said schedule to be made effective upon not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and to the public; (2) to file and make effective for the period October 10, 1932, to and including February 8, 1933, the fares, rules

and regulations set forth in Exhibit 'B' to the application herein and (3) to file and make effective on February 9, 1933, and thereafter continue in force and effect the schedule of fares, rules and regulations set forth and contained in Exhibit 'C' to the application herein."
