Decision No. 25558 BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA. In the Matter of the Application of the County of San Bernerdino, for permission to construct a crossing at grade over the tracks of the A. T. & S. F. Ry. Co., in the vicinity of East Highlands, Application No. 18610. County of San Bernardino, State of California. BY THE COMMISSION: ORDER The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino, State of California, on December 28, 1932, applied for authority to construct a public road known as East Highlands Road at grade across the track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Reilway Company, in the vicinity of the Town of East Highlands. The Atchison, Topeka and Senta Fe Railway Company on January 7, 1933, signified, in writing, that it has no objection to the construction of said crossing at grade. It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, that it is neither reasonable nor practicable at this time to provide a grade separation or to avoid a grade crossing

with said track at the point mentioned and that the application should be granted, subject to certain conditions,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino, State of California, is hereby authorized to construct East Highlands Road at grade across the

track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company at the location more particularly described in the application and as shown by the map attached thereto, subject to the following conditions and not otherwise: The above crossing shall be identified as Crossing No. 2U-15.2. The entire expense of constructing the crossing shall be borne by applicant. The cost of (2) maintenance of that portion of said crossing outside of lines two (2) feet outside of the outside rails shall be borne by applicant.
The maintenance of that portion of the crossing between lines two (2) feet outside of the outside rails shall be borne by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall perform all actual work of constructing the crossing between lines two (2) feet outside of the outside reils. (3) The crossing shall be constructed of a width of not less than thirty (30) feet and at an angle of thirty-five (35) degrees to the railroad and with grades of approach not greater than three (3) per cent; shall be constructed equal or superior to type shown as Standard No. 2 in our General Order No. 72; shall be protected by a Standard No. 1 crossing sign, as specified in our General Order No. 75, and shall in every way be made suitable for the passage thereon of vehicles and other road waffic. (4) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the installation of said crossing and of its compliance with the conditions hereof. (5) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order. (6) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders, relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection -2of said crossing, as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, public convenience and necessity demand such action.
