FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

ORIGINAL

Southern Pacific Company, applicant herein, having requested modification of the Commission's Decision No. 13735 dated June 23, 1924, in the above entitled application, to the effect that Condition (3) of said decision be changed to provide that a human flagman be maintained for the protection of the crossings therein authorized only during the fruit shipping season of each year, instead of throughout the entire year; it appearing that this request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (3) of the above-mentioned Decision be modified to read as follows:

- (3) A human flagman shall be maintained for the protection of said crossings between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. daily during the period from approximately July 1st to October 1st of each year.

In all other respects the Commission's Decision No. 13735 shall remain in full force and effect.
