The San Diego and Arizona Railway Company has filed with the Commission the above entitled application for authority to construct and operate a side track to serve the Union Ice Company's icing platform located at Boal Station, San Diego County, California, with impaired clearance.

Applicant desires to construct and operate a side track serving the icing docks of Union Ice Company with a side clearance between center line of track and nearest projection of icing platform of 7' 8".

The Commission has in its order in Decision No. 19458, on Application No. 14011, provided for a minimum clearance for icing docks and platforms of 7' 8" from the center line of track.

It appearing to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be

and it is hereby granted to applicant, the San Diego and Arizona Railway Company, to construct and operate a side track serving the Union Ice Company's icing platform located at Boal Station, in the County of San Diego, State of California, with a side clearance between center line of track and icing platform of 7' 8",

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
