FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the second and fourth paragraphs of the order in Decision 25565 of January 16, 1933, in the above entitled proceeding be and they are hereby amended to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that respondent United Parcel Service of Los Angeles Inc. be and it is hereby directed to file and make effective on or before February 25, 1933, on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission, a new tariff embodying the changes outlined in the foregoing opinion, which tariff shall be subject to approval by the Commission and shall in no case contain increases over the rates now on file unless specific authority is previously obtained.

"The effective date of this order shall be February 25, 1933."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects our Decision No. 25565 of January 16, 1933, shall remain in full force and effect.
