OPINION and ORDER

**ORIGINAL**

Victor Torres, operating a transportation service of passengers and property under the name Torres Stage Line, between San Luis Obispo and Simmler and certain intermediate points, by authority of Decision No. 23076, on Application No. 17000, has made application to abandon all such service and for the revocation of his operating rights. He alleges that lack of patronage and competition by uncertificated carriers has reduced his revenues to such an extent that his operations are now being conducted at a loss.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not deemed necessary. The application will be granted. Therefore,

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Victor Torres be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue all service between San Luis Obispo and Simmler and intermediate points for the transportation of passengers and property, provided, applicant shall post notice of such discontinuance at his terminals at least five (5) days before the effective date of such discontinuance and concurrently cancel all tariffs and time schedules now on file with the Commission; and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that all operating rights granted Victor Torres by Decision No.23076, on Application No.17000, be and they are hereby revoked and annulled.
